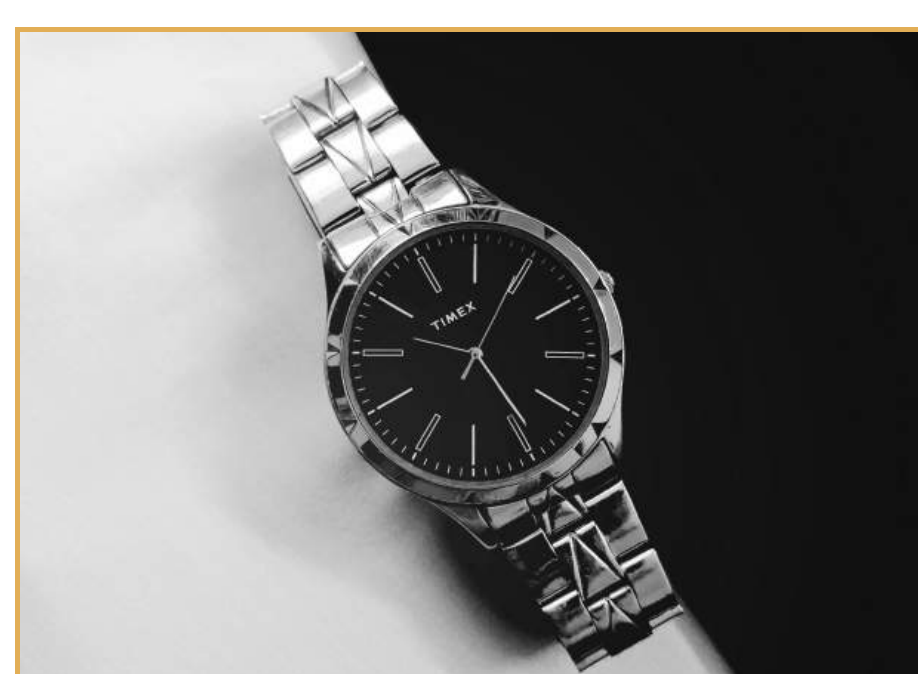


## 4. Green: You're Probably Outside Right Now
